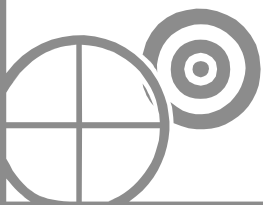

The 2010 Cub Scout Shoot-O-Ree is open to registered Cub Scouts and is especially great for boys who just joined Cub Scouts. Cub Scout-age siblings may participate, provided they pay the event registration fee and their parent is present with them.

Camp Lazarus is located on the west side of Highway 23 between Delaware and Lewis Center, across from the Delaware Area Career Center.

The check in desk will be open from 8:30AM – 3:00PM and activities will be available 9:00AM – 5:00PM each day. All registered and paid participants will receive a wristband for access to Shoot-O-Ree activities. Activities involving actual shooting require instruction and a safety briefing prior to shooting. (Safety is a key lesson to learn in life.) There will be a variety of indoor and outdoor activities, so be sure to dress for the weather. Some activities will have a small additional cost.

A Chuck Wagon will be available with a small variety of snacks for sale.

Pre-registration is strongly encouraged. Save time, money, and hassle. A roster of participants and payment is required at the time of reservation. There are no refunds, but substitutions are okay. The group leader will be given all pre-paid wristbands at the pre-registration desk day of the event.
